- 1. Teaching Assistants will run a 'Healthy Eating Cookery' after school club.
 - 2. A specialist dance teacher will be employed to deliver dance sessions for EYFS & KS1 teacher.

- 3. All children from Year 2 to Year 6 will have weekly swimming lessons with qualified instructors.
- 4. We run after school clubs 4 days per week with qualified sports coaches.
- 5. Our children participate in inter-academy sports events.
