Book: Room on the Broom

Reception: Topic: Do witches really exist?

Let's talk about it...	Let's make and do...	Let's have a go...
<b>The Room on the Broom by Julia Donaldson.</b> How do you think the witch felt when the dragon caught her in the story?	Make up a magic potion. Draw and label a picture of what you would put in it.	Continue to practise writing your name—remember to only use a capital letter at the beginning and to form your letters correctly. If you can do this already, write your surname.
Talk about your favourite part of the story. Why is this your favourite part? Draw a picture and label it.	Make/draw/paint a witch's hat and decorate it.	Make number cards to 20 and order them correctly 1-20. Take a picture of this and stick it in your homework book. Look at numbers 1-20, how many numerals do you recognise? Practise writing the ones you know.
Draw a picture of who you would take on the broom.	Make your own Christmas bauble for the tree. You could use paper, card or salt dough.	Write a list of rhyming words that rhyme with 'cat'. Practise writing the words using the Read Write Inc letter formation rhymes.
Draw a picture of all the characters from the story and label who they are.	Make/ draw a magic wand that the witch could use. Stick evidence of this in your homework book.	Make your own Christmas card for a family member or friend. Stick a photo of this in your homework book for me to see.

This homework relates to your child's learning in school, so please try to find some time to support them.
