What we are learning this half term:

## Celebrations

### Reading:

This half term the children will be learning through story books corresponding with our topic 'Celebrations'. Our main topic stories are 'Room on the Broom', 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' and 'The First Christmas'.



### Literacy:

This half term the children will continue to learn 4 new phonemes a week. They will continue to apply segmenting and blending to their reading to enable them to confidently read CVC words. More information on how phonics is taught can be found on DB Primary.

### Important Information

New reading books will continue to be sent home every Monday. Please ensure you are sharing your children's reading books at home and **returning** them every Friday. This will ensure your children are getting new books each week to share at home..

### Mathematics

This half term the children will continue to develop number compositions to 10. This will include: One more than, one less than and finding the missing number. We will also continue to match number to quantity and touch counting groups of objects.

### Topic

During our 'Celebrations' topic we will celebrate: Halloween, Black History Month, Remembrance day, Children in Need, Diwali, Bonfire night and Christmas. This topic will enable many exciting opportunities for your children to learn through.
